- Complete your Nominee Profile (see below) on a **maximum** of two 8½" x 11" sheets of paper, one-sided. Please print or type. Be sure nominee's name appears on each sheet. **Do not submit cover letters, vitae, resumes or other items.**
- Summarize your nominee's achievements. You may want to consult with others, **even your nominee**, to be sure you are including all of her activities and accomplishments. Your nomination narrative will be **the only item** the Selection Committee will consider in its decision-making process. Additionally, note that although several nominations for the same candidate may be received, the committee will review and evaluate each separately.
- All sections of the Nominee Profile will be scored equally. In narrative form, **address all areas individually and title each section to ensure the highest possible ranking for your nominee.**
- You are welcome to resubmit a past, unsuccessful nomination; however, it is highly recommended that the nomination be updated. It must also comply with the guidelines stated above.

Do NOT assume the Selection Committee is familiar with the nominee's achievements.

- DEMONSTRATED LEADERSHIP** - Give specific evidence of your nominee's leadership in her award category.
- COMMUNITY IMPACT** - Describe your nominee's influence and visibility in a sector(s) of our community and the importance that has had on the greater community. Also, share as appropriate, any circumstances, challenges or unique/extraordinary situations the nominee has faced.
- VISION** - Describe your nominee's grasp of problems and solutions in her area of endeavor.
- REFLECTION OF YWCA VALUES** - The YWCA's mission is focused on the empowerment of women and girls, and the elimination of racism. Please describe how your nominee has impacted these two values.
