2. **ACADEMIC AND/OR ATHLETIC ACCOMPLISHMENTS** - Summarize your nominee’s achievements in one or both of these areas.
3. Describe the **POSITIVE IMPACT** the nominee’s actions/activities have had on her life and/or on the lives of others.
4. **REFLECTION OF YWCA VALUES** – The YWCA's mission is focused on the empowerment of women and girls, and the elimination of racism. Please describe how your nominee has impacted these two values.
