3. All sections on the Nominee Profile (see below) will be scored equally. **In narrative form, please address all areas individually and title each section, to ensure the highest possible numeric ranking for your nominee.**

1. **LEADERSHIP** – Summarize and give specific evidence of your nominee's leadership.
2. **ACADEMIC AND/OR ATHLETIC ACCOMPLISHMENTS** - Summarize your nominee's achievements in one or both of these areas.
3. Describe the **POSITIVE IMPACT** the nominee's actions/activities have had on her life and/or on the lives of others.
4. **REFLECTION OF YWCA VALUES** – The YWCA's mission is *Empowering Women and Girls; Eliminating Racism; Promoting Peace, Justice, Freedom and Dignity for All*. Please describe how your nominee has demonstrated these values.
